

Terms and Conditions – 12 days of giving charity donation prize draw

- Entry to the prize draw is free. No purchase necessary.
- The Promoter is Ecclesiastical Insurance Office Plc (company registered number 24869, Beaufort House, Brunswick Road, Gloucester, GL1 1JZ).
- Eligible Charity is any charity registered with: the Charity Commission in the UK, the Charities Regulator in the Republic of Ireland, the Jersey Charity Commissioner or the Guernsey Registry as applicable in respect of the Channel Islands, or the Central Registry in respect of the Isle of Man; or a not-for-profit organisation, in all cases that DOES NOT: (a) discriminate unlawfully in any way, as determined by the sole discretion of the Promoter; (b) support any specific political party or affiliated group; (c) relate to any controversial subject matter that is contrary to the values and expectations of the Promoter.
- The prizes are as follows: 120 prizes of £1,000 each (or the equivalent in Euros at the time of payment (if delivery of the Prize is to take place in the Republic of Ireland) in the form of a cash donation to be given by the Promoter to 120 Eligible Charities nominated by the Winners (as defined below) (each a "Prize" and together "the Prizes").

Valid applications submitted after 12.00 midnight will be entered into the next available draw. The Promoter will accept no responsibility for incomplete or un-submitted entries. Illegible entries or entries submitted after 12.00 midnight on Thursday 19th December will be void and not accepted.
- Only one Eligible Charity to be nominated on each Application.
- An Eligible Charity can only win one prize and once drawn will be removed from all subsequent draws.
- Entries nominating organisations that do not fall within the definition of an Eligible Charity, as set out above, will be void and will not be accepted. Only Eligible Charities approved by the Promoter at the Promoter's sole discretion will be eligible to receive a Prize.
- By entering the prize draw, you hereby consent to the Promoter processing your personal data for the purposes of running this prize draw, for announcing the Winners on the Promoter's website and social media pages and by email.

Each Prize will be paid directly by the Promoter by BACS payment or cheque to each Eligible Charity nominated by each Winner. No correspondence will be entered into. The Winners and their nominated Eligible Charities may be contacted in relation to promotional activity. Ecclesiastical will not be responsible for any inability of the selected Eligible Charity to take up its Prize.
- Each Prize is not transferrable. The Prizes cannot be replaced if lost, destroyed or stolen or if any of the cheques are not cashed within 6 months (from the date written on the front of the cheques).
